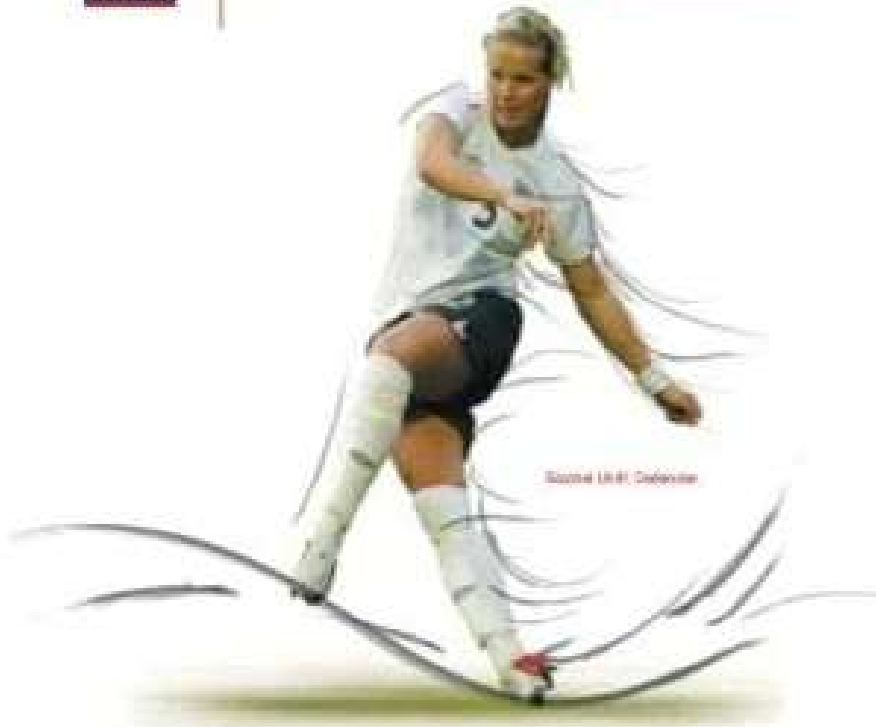
Euro 2005 Legacy
